

Specialty drugs on the Kaiser Permanente formulary

Specialty drugs are high-cost prescription medications and, in most cases, are used to treat complex chronic conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis, multiple sclerosis, or cancer. Below is a list of the specialty drugs on our formulary, which means they're covered by Kaiser Permanente plans when prescribed by a member's physician as part of a course of treatment.¹

Most specialty drugs aren't available through mail order because they require special handling such as temperature or storage requirements. A majority of specialty drugs may be limited to a 30-day supply and cannot be mailed.
