People use acupuncture for many reasons, from relieving pain to helping treat certain health conditions. Acupuncture may be helpful by itself or as part of a treatment program.

## Your Acupuncture Benefit

When clinically appropriate, your acupuncture benefit covers treatment of:

- Neuromusculoskeletal pain due to an injury or illness; or
- Allergies, asthma, nausea and/or vomiting

Your treatment may include:

- Acupuncture by manual stimulation
- Electro-acupuncture applied to inserted needles
- Acupressure
- Cupping or moxibustion covered only in lieu of electrical stimulation

You may self-refer for visits to contracted acupuncturists. Refer to your *Summary of Benefits and Coverage* form for copayment amount, number of visits covered, and other benefit information.

Some services may not be covered under this benefit, including:

- Rental or purchase of durable medical equipment
- Air purifiers, therapeutic mattresses, supplies, or similar devices, appliances, and equipment
- Massage or soft tissue techniques, except acupressure
- Treatment mainly for obesity or weight control
- Hypnotherapy
- Addiction (this includes quitting smoking)
